Procedure of the Historical Security Council of MUNoH 2015

Debates of the Historical Security Council of MUNoH 2015 will be divided into three instances which will be the following:

The first phase – October 12th, 2001

The second phase – December 21st, 2001

The end of the invasion of Iraq was declared by US President George W. Bush after the conquest of Baghdad and the fall of the Iraqi dictator Saddam Hussein.

In the following document you will find detailed reports about each instance as well as a summary of the terrorist attacks on September 11th, 2001. Please be aware of the fact that in each phase the final date of action considered will be the one named above. Any event after those dates should not be included in the debate.

Nevertheless we highly recommend to research even further than May 2003 in order to inform yourselves about the opinions of your represented country to obtain some knowledge about any actions taken in that time, which were revealed to the public after that very date. Furthermore we would like to remind you delegates that our forum's purpose is, along solving the problems, to maybe change the way to handle the challenge of 9/11 and not repeat history all over again.

Therefore you should put a lot of effort in researching the issue in great detail and think about what the Historic Security Council possibly can do better than the Security Council in 2001 to 2003 for the purpose of a peaceful and sustainable solution. Since the Historical Security Council will have an ad-hoc debate, just like the Security Council, please be prepared with a well drafted working paper with already formulated operative clauses.
